Tahiti Girls- Bring a pareu to practice and a fitted shirt or crop shirt will be great. Please no jeans
Tahiti, & Maori Boys- Wear workout shorts and a shirt/tank. Loose clothing will be most comfortable for the boys training.

Hawaii Dancers (Girls only)- Please bring a Pahu if you have one.

Maori (Girls Only)- Always bring your Poi balls

Samoa dancers- Please bring a LavaLava.

Costume Workshops

All island accessories will be created during costume workshops.

TeHamata parents will help with their own child's costumes. We do have costume workshops available thru the month of July & August. We are always looking for Volunteer Seamstress to add to our team moms. Dancer's old enough to do their own costumes are welcome to the workshop but usually we have costume workshops during practices.

The end of July, we will combine all teams as a group every week for Practices. Group Dance practice's location & Time- TBA

All Practices should be **Mandatory**, However, if you absolutely need to be excused please let us know. Practices will run through the month of August but it will be once a week with the whole team when we begin performing for the Summer shows.
