Payment option # 1:

Payment in Full - One-time Payment (via Venmo, Cash app, Zelle)

Payment Option # 2: Full bill split in 2 payments

- 1st Payment due the day of Registration (via Venmo, Cash App, Zelle)
- 2nd payment due July 5th (via Venmo, Cash App, Zelle)

Payment Option # 3: Full bill split in 3

- 1st payment due the day of Registration (in person or via Venmo, Cash App or Zelle)
- 2nd payment on July 5th (via Venmo, Cash App, Zelle)
- 3rd payment on August 2nd (via Venmo, Cash App, Zelle)

- Auto withdrawal from a credit card once a month on a date specified.

Costume Workshops

All island accessories will be created during costume workshops.

TeHamata parents will help with their own child's costumes. We do have costume workshops available through the month of July till August 2nd. We are always looking for Volunteer Seamstress to add to our team moms. Dancer's old enough to do their own costumes are welcome to the workshop but usually we have costume workshops during practices.

The 2nd week of July we will combine all teams as a group every week for Practices to help prepare for the Festival performances.

Group Dance practice's location & Time- TBA

All Practices should be Mandatory, However, if you absolutely need to be excused please let us know.

Practices will run through the month of August & mid September but it will be once a week as a whole team. Parents, we ask that you please adjust your schedule to make sure your/child is there at all practices especially if we have a show that weekend. Juaul & Moni may need to have your child(s) sit out of the upcoming performances if there are too many missed practices or if they feel you; your child(s) isn't ready to hit the stage. Please continue to attend practices so you; your child(s) is ready for the next show.

TeHamata's communication tool

If you do not have a Slack App on your phone, please expect a text from Juaul or Moni with a link to be added to our page. If you don't have the app please download it when we send the link so we are able to stay connected throughout the whole season.
